- **October 15th Harris County & North Channel LEPC HHW Collection Event from 9 AM-2 PM:**
Crosby High School, 14703 FM 2100, Crosby, TX 77532
- **October 29th Harris County HHW Collection Event from 8 AM - 2 PM:**
University of Houston - Clear Lake, 2700 Bay Area Boulevard, North Student Parking Lot D
- **November 5th Harris County HHW Collection Event from 8 AM - 2 PM:**
Sam Houston Race Park, 7575 North Sam Houston Parkway West, Houston, TX 77064

These events provide Harris County residents with a convenient location for the safe disposal of various household contaminants. Items that will be accepted include paint products, yard care chemicals, automotive products, household cleaners, tires, and electronics such as televisions, computers and cell phones.

Items that will NOT be accepted include commercial waste, medical waste, radioactive waste, PCBs or dioxins, ammunitions or explosives, compressed gas cylinders, microwaves, washers or dryers, refrigerators or freezers, air conditioners, photocopy machines, or smoke detectors.

In an effort to inform as many citizens as possible, we are asking area management companies to notify the neighborhoods and communities near the event locations so that the information can be included in their upcoming newsletters. Your assistance in this matter will help to ensure a successful collection, as well as to provide a valuable service your customers.
